

100 Books

On Friday, your child will come home with a '100 book'. The 100 Books are linked to our whole school agenda of promoting reading for pleasure. Each phase in school (EYFS, KS1 and KS2) has a list of age-appropriate books that the children should aim to read before they leave that Key Stage. In EYFS, the expectation is that the story is shared with an adult so that they can listen to the story being read to them (children are not expected to 'read' the story but may make up their own narrative to match the pictures).

When your child comes home with their 100 Book on a Friday, this is yours to keep and share before it needs to be returned the following Thursday so it can be swapped on the Friday. **Please keep your 100 Book at home until you are finished with it; it only needs to come in every Thursday and does not need to be in school each day. Children will then pick a new book on the Friday.**

Due to the number of books that were damaged or went missing last year, we will not be able to send your child home with a new 100 book until the previous one is returned. If you still have a book outstanding at the end of a half-term, you will be asked to buy a replacement or asked to give a fee to the value of that book.
