Dear Parents and Carers,

Please read the information below regarding the organisation of our Sports Day this year.

Sports Day Dates 2026

Nursery	Birklands, Thursday 16 th July, 10:30am-11:30am. Parents/carers to arrive at main reception for 10:30am. A member of staff will greet you at this time.
Reception	Meden Field, Monday 13 th July, 9:15am – 10:15am.
KS1	Meden Field, Monday 13 th July, 10:30am – 12:00 noon.
KS2	Meden Field, Monday 13 th July, 1:00pm – 3:00pm. Children will need to return to school for collection as normal.

All children will need to come dressed in their PE kit. A reminder that this is black shorts and a white/burgundy t-shirt. **Please make sure that your child brings in sun cream, a sunhat and a water bottle. Please ensure that**

Reception

We ask that children arrive at school at 8:35am on the day of Sports Day so that they can be registered. Can parents please meet us at Meden field.

KS1/KS2

Please arrive at Meden Field no more than 15 minutes before the session start time listed above. This will give time for parents/carers to leave before the next session starts. Parents/carers will then be invited to sit/stand in the marked area. Please bring a chair or picnic blanket with you.

It is imperative that parents/carers stay in the marked area throughout the Sports Day sessions and do not cross the tape. Please do not stand at the end of the race track, as this makes it difficult to finish the races and support the children with getting back to their coloured area. This will ensure that the day can run successfully, and that races are not interrupted and all children can be accounted for. Anything your child may require for the day e.g. a drink or hat, needs to be brought to school with them that morning. Staff will be there to support children throughout the day.

As always, you are more than welcome to take photos of your child but these are for personal use and not to be shared on social media.

Children have been placed in one of four teams (Red, Yellow Green, Blue), made up of children from each year group. Each child will take place in at least a running race and 'novelty race'. Points will be counted on the day and a winning team for each Key Stage will be announced. An overall school winner will be announced in Assembly.

The children have been working hard during their PE lessons in preparation for the day and we look forward to you coming to support and cheer them on.
