

Information about Sports Day 2025

Dear Parents and Carers,

Here is a reminder of information regarding the organisation of our Sports Day this year.

Sports Day Dates 2025:

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| Nursery and Reception | Meden Field, Friday 27 th June, 9:15am – 10:15am. |
| KS1 | Meden Field, Friday 27 th June, 10:30am – 12:00 noon. |
| KS2 | Meden Field, Friday 27 th June, 1:00pm – 3:00pm. <i>Children will need to return to school for collection as normal.</i> |

In the event of rain or extreme heat, the 'back-up date' is Thursday 10th July.

All children will need to come dressed in PE kit. A reminder that this is black shorts and a white/burgundy t-shirt.
Please make sure your child brings in named sun cream, sunhat and water bottle.

Nursery and Reception

We are excited to have both Nursery and Reception taking part in our EYFS Sports Day this year! We ask that children arrive at school at 8:35am on the day of Sports Day, so that children can be registered etc. **NURSERY** - We would appreciate the support of parents and carers to walk with the children to Meden Field. **RECEPTION** – Parents can meet us at Meden field.

KS1/KS2

Please arrive at Meden Field no more than 15 minutes before the session start time listed above. This will give time for parents/carers to leave before the next session starts. Parents/carers will then be invited to sit/stand in the marked area. Please bring a chair or picnic blanket with you.

It is imperative that parents/carers stay in the marked area throughout the Sports Day sessions and do not cross the tape. Please do not stand at the end of the race track, as this makes it difficult to finish the races and support the children with getting back to their coloured area. This will ensure that the day can run successfully, and that races are not interrupted and all children can be accounted for. Anything your child may require for the day e.g. a drink or hat, needs to be brought to school with them that morning. Staff will be there to support children throughout the day.

As always, you are more than welcome to take photos of your child but these are for personal use and not to be shared on social media.

Children are being placed in one of four teams (Red, Yellow Green, Blue), made up of children from each year group. Each child will take place in at least a running race and 'novelty race'.

Points will be counted on the day and a winning team for each Key Stage will be announced. An overall school winner will be announced in Assembly.

The children have been working hard during their PE lessons in preparation for the day and we look forward to you coming to support and cheer them on.
