

Dear Year One Parent/Carers

As mentioned in my previous letter school will be welcoming our year one pupils back to school on Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> June.

We have provisionally prepared three of our classrooms for our year one pupils. All the rooms have been prepared to comply with the most recent guidelines, along with advice from the Trust.

During the day, each class base will be cleaned, while the children and their staff member are having their lunch.

As mentioned previously your child will be in a bubble (class base) with a familiar adult. Please note there is no guarantee that your child will be in bubble with Mrs Evans.

Each bubble will have a different start and finish time to enable all children to enter the school safely. If you miss your allocated time, you will need to wait until all groups are in before bringing your child to school.

At the main school gate, your child will be met by a member of staff and directed to the entry point they must use to enter school.

As mentioned previously we are currently not allowing any parents onto the school grounds. This new approach will being on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June and will affect key-worker parents too.

All year one pupils qualify for universal free school meals therefore a packed lunch will be provided by the school to all children, unless indicated otherwise on the survey. Currently, the school will only offer a packed lunch to pupils as it reviews keeping our catering staff safe, while preparing meals.

## Additional information you need to know:

- Children will not be required to wear their uniform. They will need to be wearing a clean set of clothes each day
- All children will be required to bring their own water bottle
- If a child decides to bring their own lunch this should be brought in a carrier bag
- We will not be able to offer breakfast club or our wrap around after-school care
- Within each bubble every child will be given a set place to sit and they will only use the equipment supplied by the school
- Children will be required to stay in their place apart from when they need the toilet
- Staff will be issued with PPE and will wear this if they choose to
- Children will be required to wash their hands frequently while in school
