Mondays 10.00 am - 1.00 pm

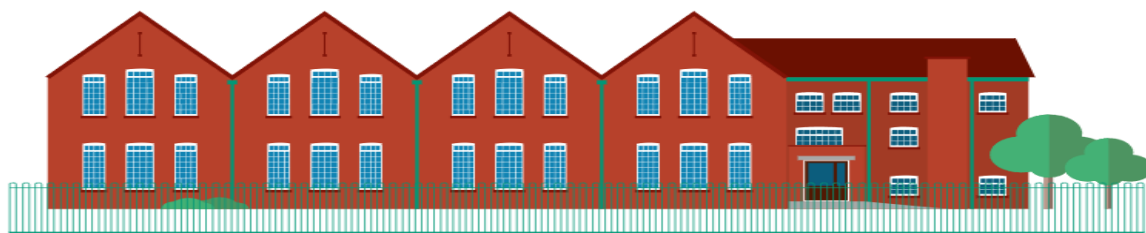
Fridays 1.00 pm - 3.00 pm
