### **Uniform and PE Expectations**

A polite reminder that all children should be in correct uniform and PE kit at all times. Our uniform consists of:

# Black shoes should be worn by all our children. No trainers allowed (unless it is a PE day).

We expect all children to wear black shorts or grey/black joggers and a white/burgundy t-shirt for their PE lessons. Football shirts or other sports wear is not allowed.

If hair is long enough to be tied up it should be on PE days please.

When earrings are worn in school, they must be small, round studs. No other jewellery is permitted.
