# School Census

This will be taking place this week on Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> January. It is vital that we have all our information up to date for this. If any parent/carer thinks that we might have out of date information about their child could you please update the school office as soon as possible. It is especially important that we have correct phone numbers and addresses. We also need to know if any of our children were not born in the UK and hold a passport for any other country apart from the UK. Again, can you please let the school office know if this applies to your child.

# Free School Meals

It is also really important that if you think you may qualify for Free School Meals that you apply for them via Nottinghamshire County Council. Information about who can apply can be found at <u>www.nottinghamshire.gov.uk/education/school-meals/free-school-meals-and-milk</u>

There is also a link to follow to apply online or alternatively you can phone 0800 500 8080. If you are successful in applying for Free School Meals then school will provide your child with a free item of school uniform.

As a school we may qualify for extra funding for any children we have who are claiming Free School Meals. Even if your child is currently in reception, Year 1 or Year 2 and is accessing the Universal Free School Meal, please apply if you think you qualify to allow us to get extra funding.
