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# Free School Meals

As you may have seen in the news, there is a possibility that Infant Free School Meals may be scrapped under a new Government. We would therefore highly recommend that you apply for free school meals so that your child can carry on receiving free meals. Details of how to apply can be found on the Notts County Council website. You may qualify for free school meals if your child attends a Nottinghamshire County Council School and you receive one of the following benefits.

- Child Tax Credit, provided they are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income (as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue & Customs (HMRC) that does not exceed £16,190
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA)
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)
- Income-based and Contributions-based JSA and ESA on an equal basis
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for four weeks after the person stops qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit during the initial roll-out of the benefit

On **Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> June**, we have arranged for the Year 2 children to visit Southwell Minster as part of their 'Time Travelling' day. The day will involve a collective worship in the Minster and learning about different aspects of Christianity linked to the Nottinghamshire syllabus for RE.

During the day your child will be spending some of the day outside so they will need to wear suitable clothing and footwear (e.g. trousers and flat school shoes). School uniform should be worn and it would be advisable to send your child with a waterproof coat as well, just in case it rains.

All children in Year 2 will be provided with a packed lunch, however if you prefer to send a packed lunch from home that's fine. If you are providing a packed lunch from home, can you send it in a disposable bag as no lunch boxes are allowed at the church. Can you also provide your child with a drink and it would be preferable for the children to bring any drinks in disposable containers.

We will be leaving school at 9am and should be back for normal school pick up. The cost of the trip will be £5. Payment can be made by cash or by a cheque made payable to Birklands Primary School. Please ensure that all money is paid to the school office by Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> June.
