Head Lice

Year 1 Trip to Yorkshire Wildlife Park

This is taking place this Thursday 27th April. The children will be leaving school at 9.00am, returning to school at approximately 3.00pm. Please ensure your child arrives to school promptly as we will need to leave on time.

During the day your child will be spending some of the time outside so they will need to wear suitable clothing and footwear (e.g. trousers and flat school shoes). School uniform should be worn and it would be advisable to send your child with a waterproof coat as well, just in case it rains.

All children will be provided with a packed lunch, unless you wish to send your child with a packed lunch from home. We just ask if you could provide your child with a drink and it would be preferable for the children to bring any drinks in disposable containers.

The trip costs £9 for children and £15 for any adults who wish to attend. If you have not yet paid, please bring the money into the school office as soon as possible.


