Alien Words	Words used to check phonics decoding skills

Blend	Saying the individual sounds which make up a		
	word and merging the sounds together to say		
	the word.		
Decoding	Breaking down a word into different phonemes		
	to help read.		
Phoneme	A single unit of sound which can be made using		
	1 or more letters eg. 'ai' 'ee' 't		
Phonics	A method of teaching children to read by		
	correlating sounds with symbols (letters/		
	groups of letters).		
Segmenting	The opposite of blending. Splitting a word into		
	individual sounds, used for spelling and writing.		
Sound	Dots which are written under a word to support		
Buttons	reading.		
Tricky	Words that are tricky to sound out or can't be		
Words	phonetically decoded.
