What to expect from the first week ...

The school year starts on the 4th September 2023.

Monday 4th, Tuesday 5th September All children will attend the morning session (8:45am – 11:55am). Children will then go home.

Wednesday 6th, Thursday 7th September All children will attend the morning session and stay for lunch (8:45am – 1:00pm). A reminder will be given about this closer to the time.

Friday 8th onwards All children will attend all day.

What to expect from the first week ...

For the first week, children will be split randomly between Robin and Puffin Class. They will spend time with all of their peers in the year group and all members of staff.

After the first week and getting to know the children, the Reception staff will discuss groupings and place your child into Robin or Puffin Class. Friendships will be considered but it is important to remember that the children spend lots of time together, across both classrooms, throughout the school day.
