



# Welcome to Birklands Primary School

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

# Arriving at school

- When arriving at Birklands you will enter through the main gates. Turn left and continue to walk down the side of the school until you reach the KS1 playground. Parents/Carers will wait here ready for the member of staff on duty to ring the school bell at 8:45am. Children will line up in their class and their teacher will be ready to lead them in to school where they will hang their belongings on their peg and enter the classroom. # A Typical Year 1 day

Time	Activity	What this will look like
8:30 – 8:45	Arrival on school playground	Children can begin to arrive on the Key Stage One playground in preparation for the doors opening. A member of staff will be on the playground from 8.30am.
8:45 – 9:00	Register and Morning Maths	Mrs Evans takes the register. Then pupils complete their morning maths session which consists of quick arithmetic questions and then tasks which help us to remember and reinforce our previous learning in Maths.
9:00 – 10:00	Maths	Each Maths session has a specific learning focus. Children are set tasks which will help them to develop fluency skills then a deeper understanding of that focus.
10:00 – 10:15	Handwriting	Handwriting practice to support correct letter formation. As the year progresses we move on to looking at handwriting joins.
10:15 – 10:30	Assembly / Snack Time	All children in Year 1 continue to receive free fruit each day.
10:30 – 10:45	Play time	Supervised outdoor play.
10:45 – 11:10	Phonics	Children are taught phonics in groups which target the phonics phase they are working at.
11:10 – 12:00	English	English teaching is based around a focus text which is used to develop skills in reading, writing and grammar.
12:00 – 12:50	Lunchtime	Pupils eat lunch and have some time to play outdoors.
12:50 – 2:00	Afternoon session 1	The learning in the afternoon is linked to our topic and may involve teaching of science, geography, history, art, DT, PE, RE, PSHE, computing or music
2:00 – 2:15	Play time	Supervised outdoor play.
2:15 – 3:00	Afternoon session 2 then home time	The second session of learning in the afternoon followed by home time.

# Reading

- Reading at home plays a vital role in developing your child's learning and can have a massive impact on their progress in school.
- Your child will bring home a book matched to their reading level and should be encouraged to talk about what is happening in the story and to make predictions as well as reading aloud. Please try to read at home 5 times a week.
- All children should have their book bag with their book and reading diary in school every day.
- **100 books to read before you leave Year 2** – all children will have the opportunity to borrow one of these books each week to take home. There are some beautiful books which you can share together. Books will have to be returned before another book can be borrowed.

# Homework

- Homework will be given out on Thursdays and should be returned no later than the following Tuesday.
- Homework will usually include English and Maths tasks which link to the work done in school that week. In addition, children will be given spellings to learn. Spelling tests will take place on Fridays each week.
- Homework is given to help your child's learning and they will need adult support and encouragement.

# Other Information

- We will have PE twice a week and all children need a PE kit for these lessons. We will let you know which days they are when our timetable is confirmed in September but it is worth keeping a PE kit in school throughout the week in case of alterations.
- To minimise lost belongings, please ensure all items and clothing are clearly labelled with your child's name. This way we can ensure items are swiftly returned to their owner.
- We understand the importance of working closely with parents, carers and the community. We respect and value the incredible children you have and want to work together to realise their full potential. We are looking forward to an exciting and productive academic year and are here for any questions or concerns you may have.
