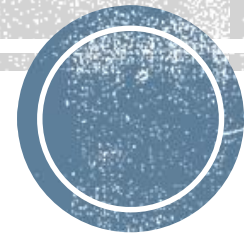
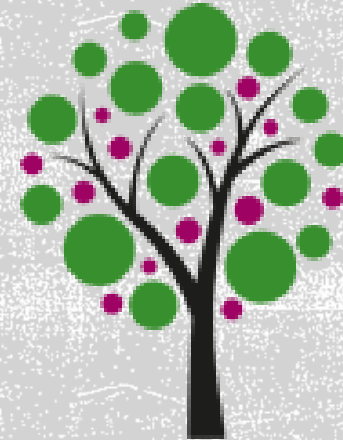

I hope that this presentation will answer any questions you have and prepare you for joining us in September.



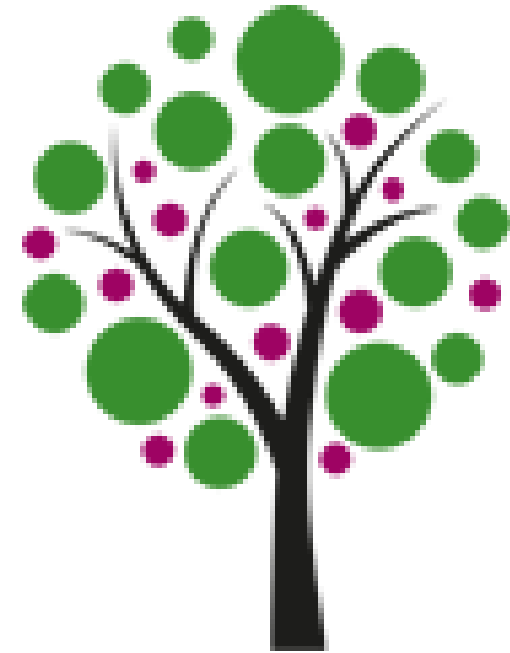

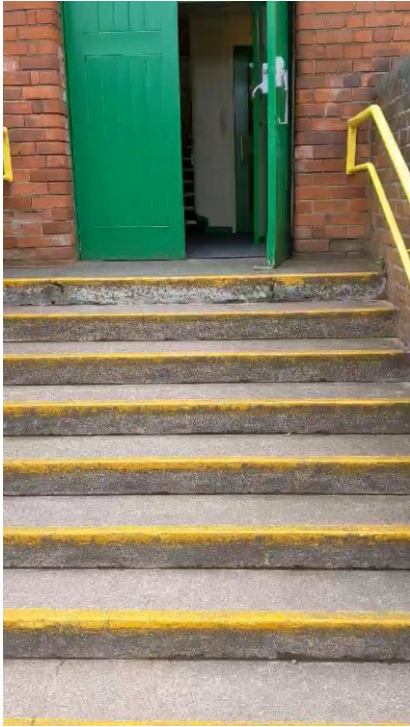

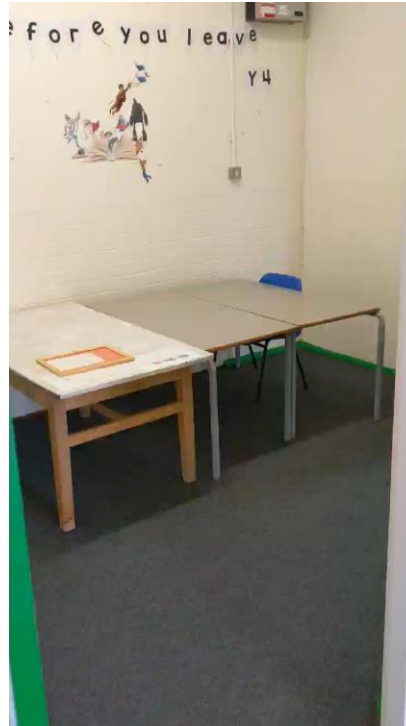

Other Information:

- Nightingale will be one of the two Year 5 classes this year. The other, Kingfisher class, will be taught by a teacher new to our school, Mr. Marsh.
