<p>Calculate it:</p> <p>1. $22 \times 5 = 110$</p> <p>2. $142 + 38 = 180$</p> <p>3. $48 \div 4 = 12$</p> <p>4. $150 - 20 = 130$</p> <p>5. $16 \times 5 = 80$</p>	<p>Solve it:</p> <p>In a school there are 189 children, 75 are girls. How many boys are there?</p> <p>$189 - 75 = 114$ There are 114 boys.</p>
<p>Explain it:</p> <p>You have taken away 7 ones (7) rather than 7 tens (70). It should be $589 - 70 = 519$</p>	<p>Challenge yourself:</p> <p>I am thinking of the number 48.</p>
